

# Let's Follow the Bicycle Traffic Rules

## There is a fine for traffic violations.



• Persons over 16 years old are subject to the rules.



• Upon committing a traffic violation, you will be handed both a (blue traffic violation ticket) and a (payment slip).



• Please pay the fine before the designated date at either a bank or a post office.

After paying, the procedures will be finished.

### Traffic Violation Examples

- There are a total of 113 different types of traffic violations. There are also violations that are not mentioned here.
- Please refer to your local police station if you have any questions.

#### Not Obeying Traffic Lights



Not obeying the traffic lights is a traffic violation. It is only permitted to advance on a **Blue Light** (Green Light).

**Fine: ¥6,000**

#### Using a Smartphone



Using a smartphone while riding a bicycle is a traffic violation.

**Fine: ¥12,000**

#### Temporary Stop • Safety Check



Not stopping at performs and performing a safety check is a traffic violation.

**Fine: ¥5,000**

#### Using Earphones



Using earphones to listen to music or not being able to hear your surroundings while riding is a traffic violation.

**Fine: ¥5,000**

#### Using an Umbrella while Riding



Using an Umbrella while riding a bicycle is a traffic violation.

**Fine: ¥5,000**

#### Passing on the Right Side



Riding on the right side of the road is a traffic violation.

**Fine: ¥6,000**

#### Riding Without Lights



Riding a bicycle at night without lights is a traffic violation.

**Fine: ¥5,000**

#### Parallel • Tandem Riding



Riding parallel is a traffic violation.



Two people riding on one bicycle is a traffic violation.

**Fine: ¥3,000**

○ If you use a child seat, riders over the age of 16 can have up to two children on the same bicycle.

○ In principle, riding on the sidewalk is a traffic violation, however, (Fine: ¥6,000) There are various exceptions based on age and other conditions.
